Job Title: Biodiversity Assistant

An exciting volunteer opportunity has arisen with Sutton Nature Conservation Volunteers (SNCV) and Sutton Council's Biodiversity Team. This trainee position is an excellent opportunity for a motivated individual with a keen interest in nature conservation to gain valuable experience in working towards a career in this competitive sector.

The successful candidate will be supporting the SNCV and Biodiversity Team in the day-to-day running of Sutton's nature reserves. The candidate will assist with practical volunteer days, as well as surveys and monitoring of local wildlife. The Biodiversity Assistant will be involved in engaging the public with the work undertaken by the SNCV and Biodiversity Team; which includes writing regular blog posts and managing social media sites, as well as assisting with environmental events.

The ideal candidate should have a proven interest in nature conservation and a desire to learn new skills. Relevant and appropriate training will be provided. Candidates need to be self-motivated to deal with the busy workload and simultaneous tasks of this role.

This role is a voluntary position but travel expenses will be paid (off-peak 1-6 travelcard or equivalent) as well as any relevant training courses (i.e. first aid, use of power tools, species identification skills).

Hours required:

The successful candidate should be able to commit three days a week for 6 months, as a minimum. Candidates must be able to commit to either a Tuesday or Thursday task day, but there is flexibility around the other days. The role involves supporting and running weekend and evening events, as necessary.

Main Duties:

 Assisting with habitat management on nature reserves across the London Borough of Sutton

- Writing regular blog posts and managing social media accounts
- Assist with surveys and monitoring of local species
- Maintenance tasks, such as maintaining the tools and workshop
- In-putting survey data and performing basic analyses
- Assisting with the creation, implementation and review of habitat management plans
- Assisting with environmental education events and activities
- Supporting the Biodiversity Officer with a variety of admin jobs
